



Beautiful PEACOCK

Peacocks are birds with eye-catchingly beautiful feathers, who live together with all of God's creatures. Even if we stand out in a crowd, Jesus wants us to dwell together in peaceful unity (Psalm 133:1).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Blue, Green and Yellow Foam Sheets
- Blue and White Modeling Material
- Green and Yellow Feathers
- Black and Red Markers
- 9 Green Plastic Spoons
- 8 Blue Plastic Spoons
- 1 Old CD or DVD
- Manicure Scissors
- Aluminum Foil
- Scissors
- Toothpicks
- Cardboard
- Pencil
- Awl
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out a piece of cardboard in the shape of a peacock's body, about 3" x 5". Also cut an oval about 3" x 3 1/2" out of cardboard.



5. Insert some pieces of toothpick into the peacock's head to make a tuft. Put little balls of modeling material on the ends. Color two pieces of toothpick red and insert them to make the beak. Secure with hot glue.



9. Cut out 8 green and 8 yellow ovals and glue them to 8 blue spoons.



2. Round out the body of the peacock by hot-gluing pieces of foil to the cardboard.



6. Cut out two wings from a sheet of green foam. Glue them to the peacock. From white foam, make two narrow eyes for the peacock. Glue and let dry. Outline the eyes with black marker.



10. Cut a little off the handles of the blue spoons and hot glue them to the back of the CD as shown.



3. Glue the cardboard oval to the back of the peacock. Wrap everything with aluminum foil. Smooth out the foil with the side of a pencil. If pieces of foil come off, hot glue them back on.



7. Cut out blue and yellow ovals from foam sheets. Hot glue them onto 9 green plastic spoons.



11. Hot glue green and yellow feathers between the spoons. Glue the body of the peacock to the CD, adjusting it so it will be stable on a flat surface.



4. Roll out some blue modeling material into a thin layer. Spread the material evenly over the peacock's body. Let it dry.



8. Cut a little bit off the handles of each of the green spoons. Hot glue the spoons to the CD as shown.



12. Glue some fluffy green feathers to the root of the peacock's tail. Done! Your beautiful peacock can take up residence in your bird and animal collection.
